What more could a child ask for. Because our life was one of many blessings, we didn't feel the need to search for our birth parents. There were a few times when it entered my mind, but never did pursue it.

Six years ago I received a letter From Lutheran Social Services of SD, telling me my birth mother would like to contact me. And of course the rest is history.

Once there were two women who never knew each other, One - you do not remember, the other you call mother. One gave you emotions; the other calmed your fears. One saw your first sweet smile; the other dried your tears. Now you ask through all your tears the age-old question through the years; Heredity or environment - which are you a product of? Neither, my darling - neither - just two different kinds of love.
