Without our efforts and hours in the kitchen, at the sink, counter, stove, shopping and doing whatever was needed, it would not have happened. So ladies..... "Cheers" to us!

Several people have asked me for the recipe for the potato casserole, which I got from my daughter-in-law. I thought she was very special as this recipe always gets thumbs up. However, last month, when looking through a file of recipes I had copied 20 years ago from a rather expensive cookbook, I found the same recipe created for Cracker Barrel. Gosh golly, I was special too, just didn't know it. So, if anyone is interested in making a quick potato dish that will feed 15-20, here you go! They'll think you are special too!

CRACKER BARREL'S HASHBROWN CASSEROLE

2 lbs. frozen cubed/hashbrown potatoes (defrosted)

½ cup melted butter

1 can cream of chicken soup

1 pt. sour cream

½ cup chopped onion

2 cups grated cheddar

1 tsp. salt

¼ tsp. pepper

Combine and mix the above. Put it all in a 3 qt. casserole dish

Mix: 2 cups crushed cornflakes in ¼ cup melted butter. Sprinkle on top.

Cover and bake at 350 for about 45 minutes. Uncover if you want them a little crunchy on top.

A more economical option to the expensive 2 lb. bags of frozen potatoes is to use real potatoes and dice them yours self... or ... Cash & Carry ... has a 5lb. bag of diced red potatoes for a bit over \$6.

I guess that's all for now. Doug said I should write about my first car, so ... it was a 4 door, '64 Nova. Nothing special, except that my dad bought it for me when I was 18 so I could drive myself to work. On one trip going to Lincoln City the tranny shifted on its own and went from 60 to 30. Not a good sign. I think at 20 we traded it in on a Vega. Had to have room for the kids. End of story. We all have stories to tell. Feel free to call Diane and put your story in the Backfire. I did.

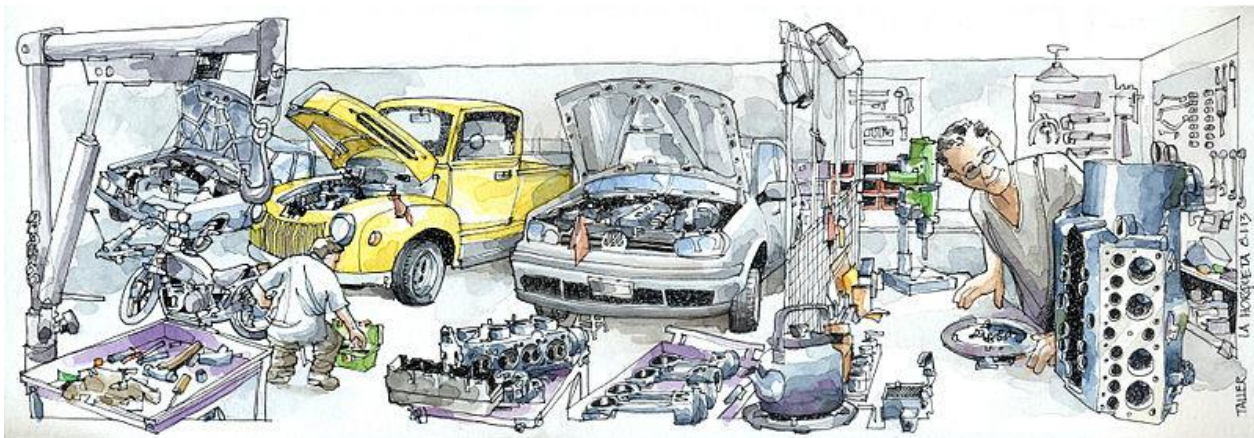
